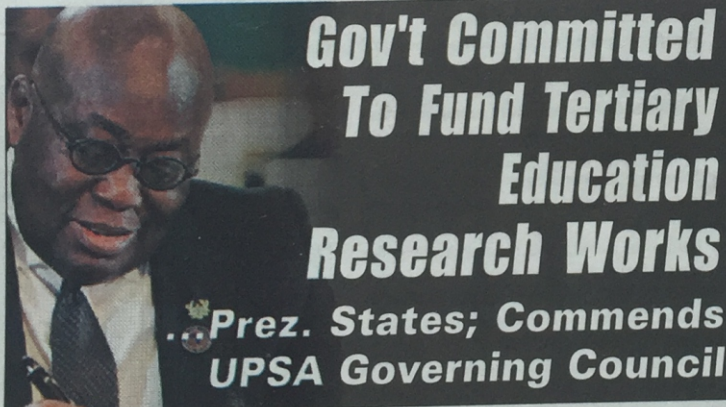

Business Man Fights Duncan Williams Over Bentley

The Chief Executive of Ghana Heights, Isaac Boakye Osei says he has petitioned the President of Ghana, Nana Addo Dankwa Akufo Addo and the Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI) of the United States of America to investigate Arch Bishop Nicholas Duncan Williams and compel him to return documents covering a plush Bentley Car the man of God allegedly took from him in 2016.

Speaking in an interview with the media, Mr Boakye Osei said on 8th September, 2016 Archbishop Duncan Williams called him on phone and explained he needed a car to pick his guest from the Airport to a site he was organizing a convention called Impact 2016.

"Based on this I released my Brown color Bentley to him to facilitate the programme. Interestingly, Archbishop Duncan Williams' changed colour of my Bentley from Brown to Off-white and also tinted the windows to hide the vehicle's original identity from the public.

When I reported him to the security services and made noise in the media, he returned the car without the original documents covering it.

We have made several attempts to retrieve the documents but to no avail. I suspect that he attempted to change the documents of the car into his name and since that failed he feared he could be exposed hence the refusal to return the original documents covering the car.

When contacted for Clarification and reaction, Bishop Kwasi Adutwum a spokesperson for the Archbishop rubbished the allegation.

"Disregard this insignificant thing; we are focused on winning soul and advancing the kingdom of God. Jesus is coming soon and we don't have time to be engaging in such frivolous activities. If we have people engaged in such issues we will never make headway in life," the man of God said.

"People have opinions about you that are far from the truth. Whatever you want to do with it you can go ahead and do it. It does not help the nation. Let everybody be judged by God. Whatever happens God is the ultimate Judge. We have serious issues to deal with not this one" he stated

Reroy cables were incorporated on the 20th April 1992 and commenced business as an importer and distributor of electrical cables and accessories.

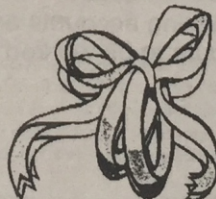
Reroy cables is a leader in the development, design, manufacture, marketing and distribution of copper and aluminum cables for the energy industry, specialty and communications markets.
